CYBERBULLYING

Cyberbullying of children is when someone uses online content or communication to seriously humiliate, harass, intimidate of threaten a child or young person under the age of 18. It can take many forms including sending abusive messages, hurtful images or videos, nasty online gossip, excluding or humiliating others, or creating fake accounts in someone's name to trick or humiliate them.

Report the online harm:

Report the content to the relevant online service provider. Many social media services, games, apps and websites have a simple process to report content posted by other people. <u>The eSafety Guide</u> has more information about how to report issues to commonly used online services.

If the service provider does not take action, you or your child can report to eSafety. They will ask you to complete an <u>online reporting form</u> and include evidence, such as a receipt, reference or report number from the service provider.

eSafety will determine whether the abuse meets the the legal definition of what can be removed. We can then take action to get serious cyberbullying material taken down and provide advice, support and assistance. ICAS

Every year FHPS provides students in Years 2-6 with the option of participating in the worldrenowned International Competitions and Assessments for Schools (ICAS) in English, Mathematics and Science. ICAS is an online academic competition that is designed to assess students' higher order thinking and problem-solving skills

Students who participate are celebrated and recognised with a printed certificate in each subject area, and an online results report to track development. Top performers are eligible for one of the highly coveted ICAS medals.

The 2024 online ICAS assessments will be held at Frankston Heights Primary School on:

IMPORTANT: Please enter your child's name accurately into the system. The details you enter are the details that will appear on your child's ICAS certificate.
