# FHPS HEALTH & SAFETY RULES

A number of health and safety rules are displayed at each entrance gate to FHPS.

All school community members are expected to follow the displayed rules.

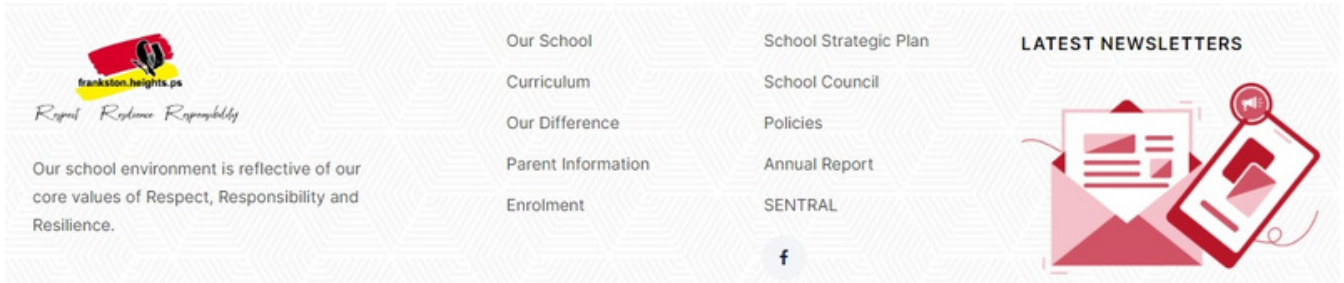

# 2024 SEMESTER 1 STUDENT REPORTS

To access your **child's** 2024 Semester 1 report follow the steps below.

- Log onto the **FHPS portal** via the school website (Select the tab titled **SENTRAL** at the bottom of the home page).
- Enter your unique access details (**login name and password**) and select the **Login tab**.



- From your home page go to the left hand menu and select the tab with your child's name.
- On your child's home page select the **Academic Reports** tab under your child's photograph.
- Select the **2024 Semester 1 Student Reports** link and the report will display.
- To download and save the report select the download icon, to print the report select the print icon.

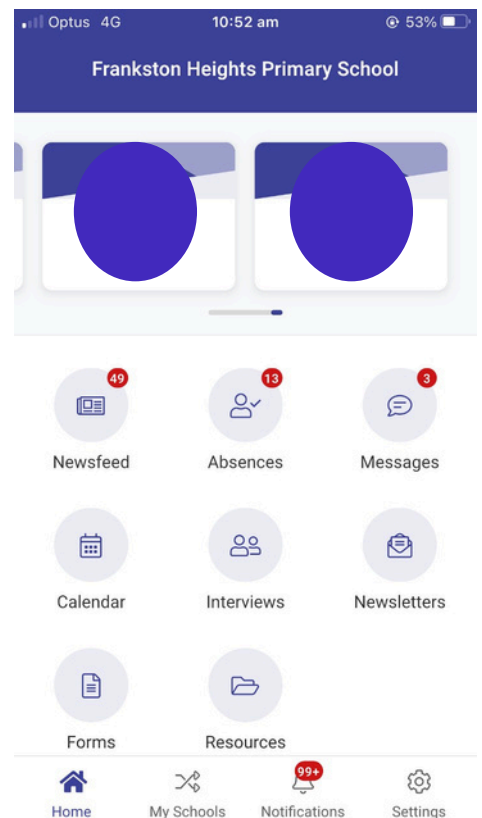
**PLEASE NOTE:** Parents are advised to download and save all documents in the **Published Reports** section.

## 2024 Year 2-6 International Competitions and Assessments for Schools (ICAS)

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Every year FHPS provides students in Years 2-6 with the option of participating in the world-renowned International Competitions and Assessments for Schools (ICAS) in English, Mathematics and Science. ICAS is an online academic competition that is designed to assess students' higher order thinking and problem-solving skills

Students who participate are celebrated and recognised with a printed certificate in each subject area, and an online results report to track development. Top performers are eligible for one of the highly coveted ICAS medals.

The 2024 online ICAS assessments will be held at Frankston Heights Primary School on:

Assessment	Date	Cost
English	Monday August 12	\$19.95 (Inc. GST)
Science	Monday August 19	\$19.95 (Inc. GST)
Mathematics	Tuesday August 27	\$19.95 (Inc. GST)

The school encourages you to consider entering your child into ICAS this year. The assessments are suitable for students in Years 2-6 wishing to extend and challenge themselves academically.

### HOW TO REGISTER & MAKE AN ONLINE PAYMENT

- Go to the Parent Portal: <https://shop.icasassessments.com/pages/pps>
- Enter our school's unique access code: **GXF105**
- Enter student details and click **SAVE STUDENT**
- Select the ICAS test(s) you wish to purchase
- Select proceed
- Add to cart
- Go to the checkout
- Make payment (you will receive an order confirmation email, keep this for your records)

**IMPORTANT:** Please enter your child's name accurately into the system. The details you enter are the details that will appear on your child's ICAS certificate.

Online payment closes **Monday 29th July 2024.**

# FHPS VOLUNTEER INFORMATION PACK

Frankston Heights Primary School values the support and assistance of volunteers. Anyone who assists with school programs is classed as a volunteer.

## **VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS**

1. Read all the documents in the Volunteer Pack below. This is a requirement for all volunteers assisting with classroom programs, excursions, sport events, camps, school concerts, fundraising events and other child-related programs.
2. Come into the school office and sign the Child Safety Code of Conduct, Volunteer Confidentiality Agreement and Volunteer OHS Checklist.
3. Present a current Working With Children Check (WWCC) to the school office. Forms can be collected from the post office or visit the Working with Children Check website at [www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au](http://www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au) A WWCC can take several weeks to be processed. However, volunteers can assist in the classroom once they have a receipt for their WWCC.
