BOOKING YOUR PARENT-TEACHER MEETING

Follow the steps below to book your parent-teacher meeting.

- Go to the FHPS website and click on the **SENTRAL** link at the bottom of the home page
Log onto the **FHPS Parent portal** using your user name and password.

OR

From the **Sentral for Parents app** select the **INTERVIEWS** tab

- Click on the **PARENT TEACHER INTERVIEW** tab on the home page or the **INTERVIEW** tab on the app.
- Select the tab titled '2025 Term 1 Parent-Teacher Meetings'
- Select **TIMESLOTS**
- Select the **time** you would like to schedule your parent teacher meeting (available times are in black, unavailable in grey). If no times display when you select a certain date e.g., Tuesday March 4, it means the teacher is not available.
- A message will appear confirming your booking. Select **SAVE BOOKING**.
- Your appointment time will be displayed. Please take note of the date and time.

In the event that you **DO NOT** have access to the internet, please contact the school office and we will enter a booking time for you.

ROADWORKS

Heatherhill Rd and Brooklyn Ave Intersection Improvement Works

Frankston Council have advised that intersection improvement works are scheduled to commence in March 2025 at the intersection of Heatherhill Road and Brooklyn Avenue.

While works are underway, Brooklyn Avenue will be closed to all through vehicle traffic with detours in place. A lane closure will also be in effect on Heatherhill Rd, with temporary traffic lights maintaining traffic flow in both directions. Your co-operation and patience during construction is requested and appreciated.
